

MCC FUTURE FUND

The MCC Future Fund is a last-dollar-in program that offers Mohave County, Arizona residents the opportunity to receive tuition assistance to attend MCC. The fund covers full tuition and standard fees that wouldn't otherwise be covered by other financial aid, including veteran's educational benefits.

Students may qualify for up to 5 years or until completion of their first degree (or certificate, if terminal program), whichever comes first. All renewal criteria must be met to continue to qualify for funding.

Students are encouraged to apply early. The MCC Future Fund is offered on a first-come, first-served basis to students who meet the qualifications as a new high school graduate or continuing student.

Preference is given to students who do not receive Federal Pell Grant, or do not have enough Federal Pell Grant to cover tuition and standard fees. Grade Point Average (GPA) and Estimated Family Contribution (EFC) as calculated upon filing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) will be used to determine qualified recipients. The EFC range used for initial awarding is subject to change based upon annual Federal Pell Grant tables and availability of funding.

To be considered for an initial award, students must:

General Requirements for MCC FUTURE FUND Recipients

- complete and submit an MCC Future Fund Success Promise annually
- declare a degree or certificate program at MCC
- enroll in a minimum of 6 credits per semester that satisfy my degree program (credits must be “financial aid” eligible)
- maintain a 2.5 cumulative GPA at MCC*
- continue to meet financial need criteria by filing the FAFSA annually
- maintain [Satisfactory Academic Progress](#) (SAP) or successfully appeal the suspension and continue meeting the terms of the appeal/academic plan at MCC
- unsuccessful SAP appeals result in permanent ineligibility for the MCC Future Fund program
- abide by the MCC Student Code of Conduct, or risk permanent ineligibility for the MCC Future Fund program

*The MCC Future Fund will be canceled at the point the student’s cumulative GPA drops below 2.5, if the student is suspended for not meeting the SAP policy, the student fails to meet the terms of the appeal/academic plan, the student fails to abide by the MCC Student Code of Conduct, or the student fails to enroll in at least 6 credits each semester. At the point of cancelation, funds will be awarded to an alternate recipient.
